The State Agriculture Department, in co-connection with the United States department of agriculture, is seen the following statement on the

"In the southeast planting conditions for peanuts have continued very favorable. In the extreme southern portion of the section the 'najor portion of the crop has been planted while farther north from 50 to 60 per cent is in the ground. All peanuts which are up are showing excellent stands and growing well.

With regard to feed, Coltrane pointed out that despite the apparent scarcity, the largest quantities of feed since the record set in 1943 are being sold. From July 1, 1945 to May 1, 1946, feed tonnage sold totaled 724,-716 tons, as against only 689,854 tons in the period from July 1, 1944 to
