

### Market Varieties Of Pecans Separate

Better prices for pecans can be obtained, if the varieties are not mixed, says Hazel Meacham of State College, in charge of Extension marketing.

He suggests that the nuts be packed in good bags, 100 pounds of nuts to each bag, and that each bag be clearly marked as to the variety it contains. Keep each variety separate. The seedlings, of course, should not be mixed with the better nuts.

Meacham says that small lots of nuts can be marketed through local buyers. For large quantities of nuts receiving stations have been opened at Whiteville and Lumberton, and another may be opened at Tarboro.

"In some sections it will pay producers to grade, bag and market their nuts cooperatively," Meacham explains. "Receiving stations can be established wherever the volume of nuts justifies it."

Where farmers have trouble in marketing their nuts, they can take the matter up with the county agent. He is in constant touch with Meacham and plans can be arranged for the pooling of the nuts on sending them to central markets.

### Soap Can Be Saved By Softening Water

Everyone wants to save as much soap as possible these days, and the best way to do this, especially with hard water, is to use washing soda as a water softener rather than an excess of soap, say the scientists and the Home Demonstration Department at State College.

Ordinary baking soda is a rather weak alkali and will not do the job. Some people think that borax is a good water softener but tests have shown that it has little softening action. The borax does aid laundering, however, by helping to sustain suds. Ammonia water is not a satisfactory softener because the amount needed cannot be calculated. If the ammonia water is too strong, the fabrics are made yellow.

The same point also applies to the use of washing soda as a softener. If the solution is too strong, the clothing will become yellow when ironed.

When using soap alone in hard water, a portion of the soap first goes to softening the water. Just what happens in this case? Some of the soap combines with the minerals in the water and a gray scum is formed. This scum sticks to the clothes that are being washed and hence the laundering job is just not done as you wish it to be.

But, washing soda will turn the trick, if used in the proper proportions. The harder the water, the more washing soda is needed.
