RECIPE FOR EASTER HAMS
 Wrap ham loosely in its inner wrapper or in clean wrapping paper. Place fat side up, on rack in open pan. Use no water. Bake in slow oven (325 F.) 18 to 20 minutes per pound (2 minutes per pound additional for half hams). When baked, remove paper and cut away and 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves, spread over ham. Score fat into 2 inch squares. Heat 1 cup currant jelly with 2 tablespoons hot water until jelly melts; spoon over ham. Return ham to slow oven (325 F.) minutes, or until well glazed. Remove from oven. Decorate in flower-petal design with blanched almond halves, maraschino cherry halves, and whole cloves. Bake 10 to 15 minutes longer, basting often.
