





Graham's political enemies are 'trying to smear him with the red brush because of his liberal philosophy. But the truth in Graham is too deep rooted in North Carolina tradition-his father was a captain in the Confederate army-to be successfully smeared.

This came up during the last war when Graham, as a member of the La-bor Mediation Board, was trying to break a deadlock between the Bendix Aviation Corporation and labor. With vital production at a standstill, Graham kept the corporation lawyers and the union representatives in almost continuous session for four days and nights.

As tempers became short, a corporation lawyer snorted that he "never saw a union you couldn't get out

"You should have talked to my father," grinned Graham. "He tried for four years to get out of a union and couldn't." The ensuing laughter broke the

tension and led to an early settlement. Though a small man, Graham is physically agile. While ice skating on a lake in Minnesota a few years back, he plunged through a hole in the ice. But the little man wriggled back on to solid ice. Later a husky lumberjack spotted the dripping Graham and ask-ed what happened. 
campaign right now with the State's moneyed interests fighting him to the tast ditch. However, North Carolina politicos predict he will once again wriggle through.
