Permanent Pastures Improved With 2, 4-D

Recent research indicates that twothirds of a pound per acre of the amine salt formation of 2, 4-D is the right amount to use on controlling most weeds in permanent pasture.

Ralph Sasser, Perquimans County farm agent for the State College Extension Service, says use of the chemical weed killer actually results in a better stand of grasses without apparent damage to white clover or lespe-

Sasser, citing the results of tests over the past three years, said that 2, 4-D is beneficial to pastures pro-vided it is used on "established grass and legume stands and that the rate of application does not exceed twothirds of a pound per acre." Heavier applications injure the legumes.

"Good clothing care can be as easy as saying your ABC's", according to Mary Em Lee, State College exten-sion specialist in clothing.

Good clothing care merely implies the kind of simple care that everyone can easily put into practice at home.

Air your clothes frequently and properly. Moths and other pests hate fresh air-so air makes a good preventative. Airing also relaxes fabrics and banishes ordinary wrinkles and creases. Clean clothes also give long-
