The Health Department has just received 3,000 c.c. of polio vaccine which will be used to give the first dose to school children in Camden and Pasquotank counties, and the parents have signed request slips for them.

The Pasquotank-Camden Medical Society approved the request for this vaccine. The Chowan-Perquimans Medical Society has approved a request for a share of this surplus vaccine and it should be here soon, stated Dr. McGuire. "Parents of 488 Perquimans County school children and parents of 623 in Camden County," he said.
