

COTTON MAID SCHEDULED TO SPEND EASTER HOLIDAYS IN BERMUDA

The Maid of Cotton will be Bermuda bound in 1957.

Plans have been completed for the cotton industry's fashion and goodwill emissary to spend her Easter holidays in Bermuda, the National Cotton Council announces.

This will be the first time that the Maid of Cotton has visited the fashionable island resort. Her five-day stay in Bermuda will be a combination work and play period and will come in the middle of her domestic tour through the United States and Canada.

The Maid will board the luxurious Viscount, British Overseas Airways Corporation's powerful new "magic carpet" airliner on April 18. The airliner will carry her to Hamilton, Bermuda, where she will rest, sun and perform her ambassadorial duties for King Cotton.

Benefit Fashion Show

During her stay on the island, the Maid will appear in an all-cotton fashion show and make good-will calls on officials of the British governed island.

The fashion show will be a benefit occasion under the patronage of

the governor and his wife, Lt. General Sir John and Lady Woodall, and will be held for their favorite charitable organization. Featured will be a special wardrobe of spring and summer cotton fashions created by top designers.

Contest Finals Set

Finals of the contest will take place in Memphis on December 27 and 28. The new Maid will leave the next day for New York where she will spend the month of January. She will be outfitted with a complete new all-cotton wardrobe, appear in fashion shows and on network radio and television shows and pose for newspaper and magazine photography.

Maid Will Sightsee

For sightseeing trips, King Cotton's lovely representative will have a choice of such historic and interesting spots as Ye Olde Towne of St. George, the colorful city founded in 112 in the heart of Bermuda, or the "Natural Bridge," a natural grey rock arch that is one of the wonders of the world. If she wishes, she may spend hours in a quaint horse and carriage driving through the countryside resplendent in Easter lilies, bougainvillea, and tropical foliage.

The 1957 Maid of Cotton Contest is sponsored annually by the National Cotton Council, the Memphis Cotton Carnival Association, and the Cotton Exchanges of Memphis, New Orleans, and New York.

On motion duly made, seconded and passed, the Board ordered that the listing of property belonging to Curtis Shambry, which has been unlisted, to be listed for a period of 5 years prior to 1956, and for the year 1956, at a valuation of \$600.00.
