May 2, 1960

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Perquimans, North Carolina, held on the first Monday in May, May 2, 1960, at 10 o'clock A. M., at its regular meeting place in the Court House in Hertford, Perquimans County, N. C. Present: R. L. Spivey, Chairman, presiding, with Commissioners Warner Madre, George W. Baker, Harry W. Winslow and G. Elwood Nowell.

Reports were received from Agriculture Extension Service and Welfare Departments.

On motion duly made and passed, the Board appropriated \$200.00 to defray clerical help expense for Soil Conservation Department, for fiscal year 1960-1961.

On motion duly made and passed, the Board authorized the installation of radio communication system in Sheriff's department and funds heretofore appropriated for Sheriff's office be expended for the system.

On motion duly made, the Board amended 1959-1960 budget to appropriate \$1,500.00 for hospitalization.

On motion duly made, seconded and passed, the Board ordered the Tax-Collector, Sheriff J. K. White, to advertise in June, 1960 and sell on the first Tuesday in July, July 5, 1960, all real estate on which 1959 taxes are due and unpaid, and to begin levying on personal property on which 1959 taxes are due and unpaid in compliance with the laws of the State of North Carolina.

On motion duly made, seconded and passed, the Board ap-

proved the appointment of Julian Broughton, Deputy Clerk of Recorder's Court, at a salary of \$50.00 per month, appointment to expire on the first Monday in December, 1960, made by W. H. Pitt, Clerk of Recorder's Court.

On motion duly made and seconded, the Board approved a tentative tax rate of \$1.25 per \$100 valuation for fiscal year 1960-1961.

On motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted to accept bids for fuel oil and kerosene to be used by County Agencies for fiscal year 1960-1961, bids are to be submitted by June 6, 1960. The Board reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids.

On motion duly made and passed, the Board authorized refund of \$20.25 to William F. Madre for error in taxes.

On motion duly made and passed, the Board appointed Mrs. Jack Kanoy delinquent tax collector for personal property, appointment to expire July 1, 1960.

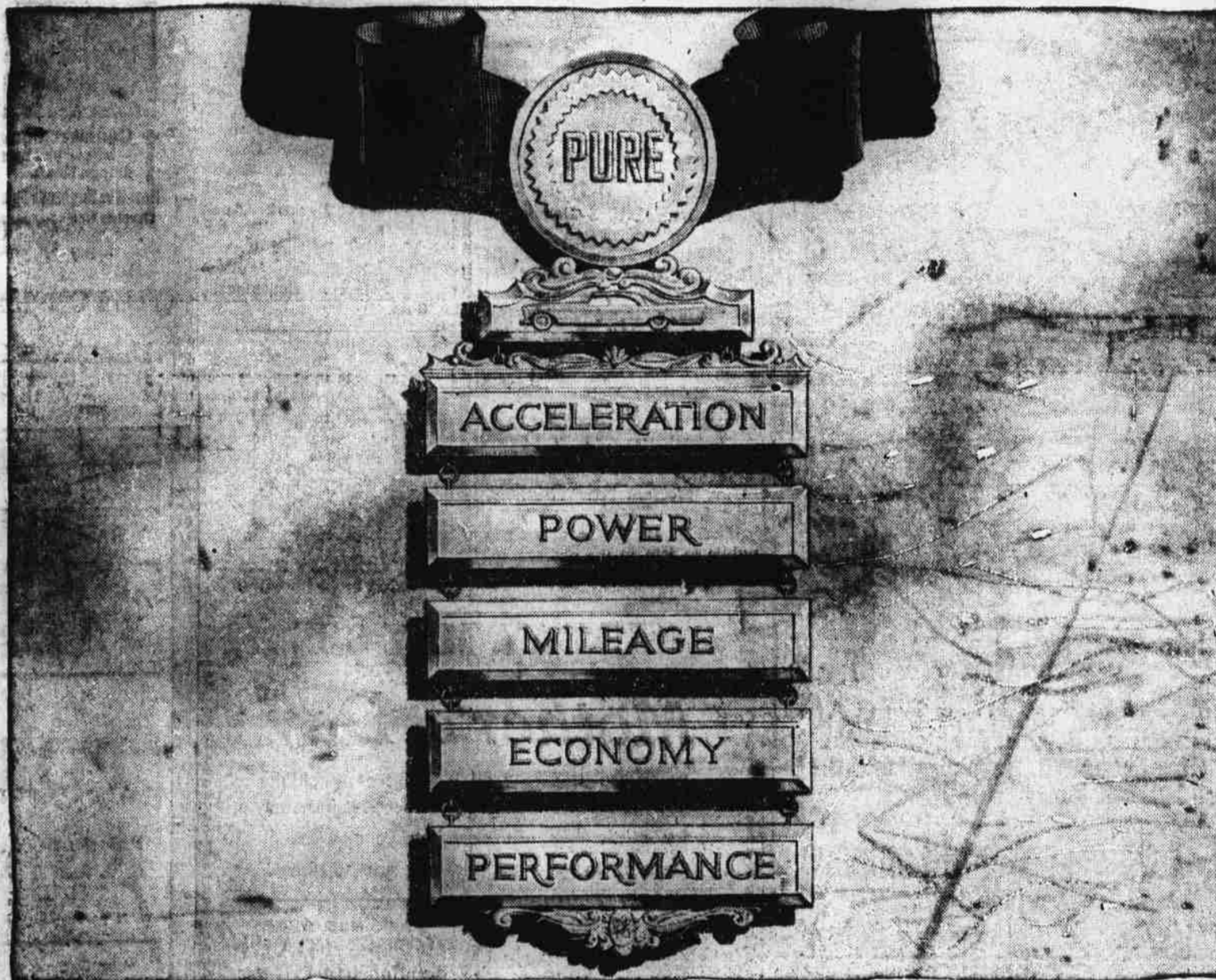
