

## 4-H Auto Project Aimed To Produce Safer Drivers

A new 4-H automotive program introduced nationally early this year has a potential membership of 400,000 boys and girls. Half this number reaches driving age each year, according to the Agricultural Extension Service which directs the program.

The project is a voluntary undertaking for older 4-H Club members to be carried out over a three-year period. Specialized training will supplement driver education courses given in many high schools, but in some instances will be the only "supervised" instruction available to 4-H'ers in their home communi-

ties. The work assignments will be guided by experienced volunteer adult leaders assisted by state and county highway engineers, police, automotive experts and others qualified to help do the job.

One workbook will be used for each year. Unit I covers "The Car and the Highway"; Unit II "Maintenance and Operation"; Unit III "Operating the Car Efficiently".

More traffic deaths and injuries occurred last year than in 1958, and 28.7 per cent of the drivers involved in fatal accidents were under 25 years of age.

Raymond C. Firestone, president of the Firestone Tire & Rubber Company, which is sponsoring the program, stated "We are particularly hopeful that this program will help reduce the high incidence of fatal accidents

among our young drivers." Those engaged in the 4-H automotive care and safety program contend that the more young people learn about the car they are driving, the less likely they are to take chances with that car.

For club members who fulfill the objectives of the automotive program, Firestone will provide a variety of awards including a week in Chicago as a delegate to the National 4-H Club Congress, plus \$400 college scholarships for six of the highest ranking 4-H'ers in the nation.

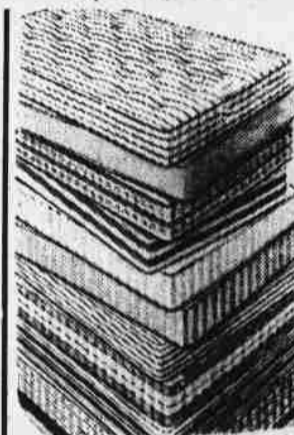
