Virginia are quarantined under amendments of the regulations in 9 CFR Part 76. Therefore, the interstate movement of swine and swine products from and through quarantined areas as contained in said Part 76, as amended, will apply to the areas quarantined.

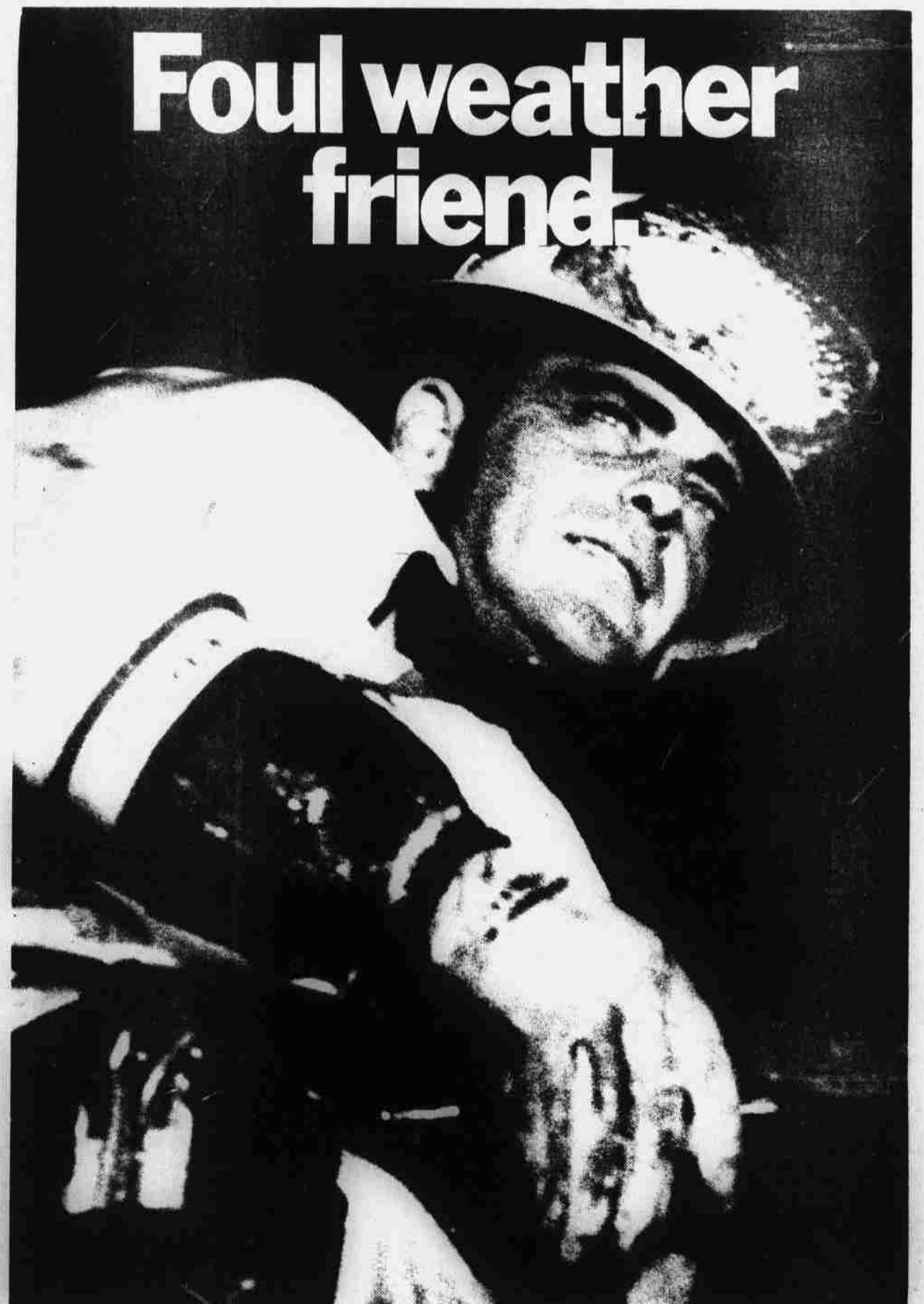
