LEGAL NOTICE
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Article 21 of Chapter 143, General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended, that a public hearing will be held by the Water and Air Quality Committee of the North Carolina Board of Water and Air Resources concerning regulations and emission control standards proposed for adoption by the Board for the purpose of controlling air pollution in the State. The hearing is scheduled to be held on December 9, 1970, in the Governor's Conference Room, Administration Building, 116 West Jones Street, Raleigh, North Carolina, beginning at 10:00 a.m. (E. S. T.).

The regulations and emission control standards to be considered include registration of sources, sampling to determine compliance and the emission of odorous substances, suspended particulate matter, and sulfur dioxide.

All persons interested in the proposed regulations and emission control standards are invited to attend the hearing and take part in the discussion. Persons desiring to be heard should notify the Board in writing on or before the date of the hearing. Written statements concerning the proposed action may be presented at the hearing or filed with the Board within thirty (30) days following the conclusion of the hearing.

Copies of the proposed regulations and standards and additional information relative to the proposed action may be obtained upon request from the Air Quality Division, Department of Water and Air Resources, P. O. Box 27048, Raleigh, North Carolina 27611.

This Is The Law

CAPITAL PUNISHMENT
What crimes are punishable by death in North Carolina? Murder in the first degree, burglary in the first degree, rape, and arson.

If at the time of rendering its verdict in open court, the jury shall so recommend, the punishment for any of these crimes may be imprisonment for life in the State's prison. Crimes punishable by death are frequently called "capital crimes."

How is the death penalty administered in North Carolina? Death sentences for crimes committed subsequent to July 1, 1935, are carried out by the administration of lethal gas. If a person should be arrested and convicted today for a capital crime committed prior to July 1, 1935, the death sentence would be carried out by electrocution.

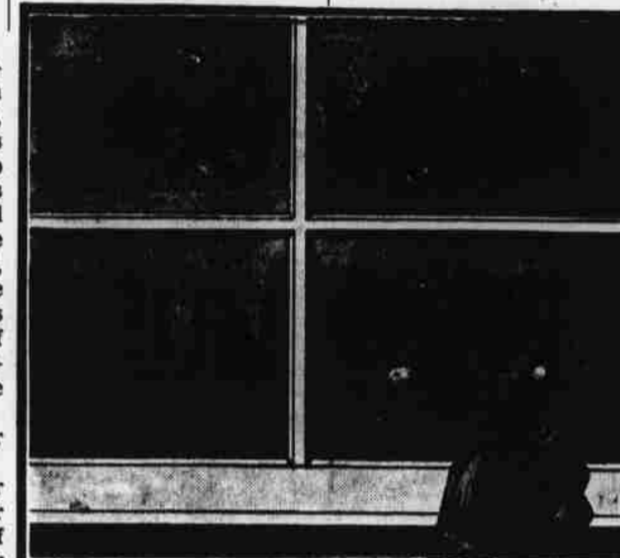
