1 cup flour 1 cup ground pecans 1 tablespoon paprika

Melt margarine in large shallow baking dish (about 13x9x2 inches). Mix buttermilk with egg in one shallow dish, and flour, ground pecans, paprika, salt, pepper and sesame seeds in another.
