Cold Winter Weather Should Help Chill Beetle Outbreak Across State

The southern pine beetle outbreak currently raging across much of North Carolina will subside as cold weather arrives and the tree-destroying insects become inactive.

In the meantime, North Carolina State University extension forest resources specialists suggest that there is little that can be done to stop the pest. The best hope is to slow the beetle by removing infested trees and destroying them before the beetles leave the tree. If the tree is brown, it's too late, in almost all cases.

NCSU Specialist Fred Whitfield pointed out that there is no need to hurry to destroy dead trees, because the beetles have already left these.

Eye Strain Can Result In Squinting, Soreness

RALEIGH — Squinting and sore, aching bloodshot eyes are often the results of eye strain.

You can prevent or correct many problems leading to sore, tired eyes, just by making sure you have the proper amount and quality of light with which to work, believes Mrs. Edith McGlamery, extension house furnishings specialist, North Carolina State University.

Shield your light sources to stop direct glare, she advises. Use a lampshade or plastic or frosted glass globe around the bulb. And place the light source above your normal viewing angle to minimize direct glare.

When light does reflect off a surface, such as a glass tabletop, it causes indirect glare, the specialist says. To correct this, merely change the position of the light source or the reflecting surface.

Shadows, too, may cause eyestrain. A more general room lighting will help correct this. And if any part of your body blocks out light from your viewing task, Mrs. McGlamery suggests you reposition your lamp.

And adequate general room lighting can cut down on the shape contrasts between your work area and its surroundings. Light-colored wall and ceiling surfaces also improve general illumination by reflecting light back into a room.

"Actually, you might do more harm than good by removing these dead trees too quickly," Whitfield said, explaining that, while the beetles leave the trees before it turns completely brown, beneficial insects and parasites linger. If the brown or dead tree is cut and burned too quickly, the beneficial predators are destroyed but not the beetles.

"The time to harvest trees and burn them (in accordance with state and local regulations) is at the early infested stage while the trees are still green," Whitfield pointed out. "The beetles are still in these trees and can be killed by cutting and spraying with the recommended insecticide or burning."

The NCSU specialist cautioned against storing this infested wood for later use in the fireplace without spraying it. On the other hand, wood from brown or dead trees can be kept without spraying it.

If the tree is infested, it's useless to try to save it. It should be removed. "Tree owners are reluctant to cut a tree as long as it has any green needles. They are hopeful it will recover," Whitfield observed. "This is a mistake. If you discover beetles in the tree, cut it and burn or spray it before the beetles leave and go to another tree."

The infested tree may have small reddish-brown globs of resin with a hole in the center of each. The attack starts in the bark of the middle and upper sections of the trunk.

Ten days to two weeks after the tree has been attacked, the needles turn yellowish-green. As the infestation progresses, the needles turn a deep yellow, and this is about the time the beetles leave to infest other trees.

One sure sign that the beetles have left a tree is tiny holes in the bark. Whitfield says the tree will appear to have been

shot with bird-shot from a shotgun.

To confirm the attack, the bark may be peeled off of a section. There will be winding, S-shaped tunnels on the inner side.

The beetle itself is reddish-brown or black and about the size of a grain of rice. It attacks all species of pines in North Carolina. It becomes active in the spring about the time the dogwoods and redbuds begin to bloom and remains active throughout the warm part of the year.
