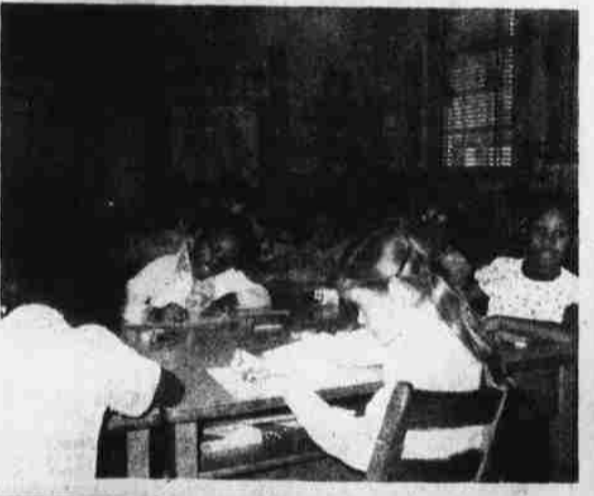
The quietly dignified service was followed by a reception in the church's social hall.
