

Schools participate in screening

The Perquimans County Schools in cooperation with the Perquimans County Health Department will

begin screening children in grades 4-6 for Scoliosis (curved spine). Scoliosis or curved spine

is a condition where there usually exists two curves; the original curve of the spine and a compensatory

curve in the opposite direction. This condition can develop in five to ten children out of every 100, and two to four per 1,000 will require treatment. If this condition is detected early enough, a severe, painful and costly deformity may be prevented.

The screening for Scoliosis will be performed by the Health Department school health nurse and/or school health nurse who is specially trained to look at the child's back. The screening process involves a simple "forward bending test."

of Representatives

Evans seeking state house seat

Charles D. Evans of Nags Head has filed with the Dare County Board of Elections as a candidate for the North Carolina House of Representatives District One which includes Dare, Tyrrell, Currituck, Camden, Pasquotank, Chowan, Perquimans and Washington counties.

Evans will stand for election with Vernon James of Elizabeth City and W. Stanford White of Manns Harbor, incumbents, for the two seats allotted the district.

A native of Dare County, Evans graduated from Manteo High School in 1963, from UNC-Chapel Hill with a B.A. in economics in 1967 and from UNC Law School with a J.D. degree in 1971. He has served six terms in the U.S. Army Reserve.

Since 1971, he has been a practicing attorney in Dare County with offices in Manteo.

Active in municipal, county and state affairs since his return to Dare County, Evans presently serves as Mayor of Nags Head. He was elected to serve on the town board in 1973 and was named mayor by the board in 1975 and again in December, 1977.

Evans was appointed by

Governor Jim Hunt to the 13-member Coastal Resources Commission in September, 1977. Previously, he had served on the Coastal Resources Advisory Council since its inception in 1974.

Evans is presently serving as first vice-president of the Albemarle Law and Order Association and was recently elected a vice-president of the Albemarle Area Development Association (AADA) representing Dare and neighboring counties.

He has served a three-year term on the board of directors of the Outer Banks Chamber of Commerce and its first vice-president and board member of the First Flight Society.

He is chairman of the board of the First Union National Bank of Kill Devil Hills. Evans is a member of the Dare County Bar Association, the North Carolina Bar Association and the American Bar Association. He is a member of the Manteo Rotary Club and Mount Olive United Methodist Church.

He is married to the former Rebecca Aydtlett of Elizabeth City and is a resident of Nags Head.



SEEKING REELECTION - Senator J.J. "Monk" Harrington has announced his intention to run for reelection to the North Carolina Senate for the 1979 Session of the General Assembly. Senator Harrington, a native of Lewiston, N.C., and president of Harrington Manufacturing Co., has served the First Senatorial District continuously since 1963 for a total of eight two-year terms. He has chaired the Transportation Committee for the last ten years. During this interim Senator Harrington is serving on the Legislative Services Commission and is one of three senators serving on the Utility Review Committee, an independent study committee monitoring the state's public utilities.
