

Library suggests new books for summer reading entertainment

The Perquimans County Library suggests these new titles as good summer reading.

Helprin, Mark. "Winter's Tale." Harcourt Brace Jovanovich, 1983.

"...Time, however, can be easily overcome; not by chasing the light, but by standing back far enough to see it all at once.

The universe is still complete. Everything that ever was, is; everything that ever will be, is...and so on, in all possible combinations."

On page 360 of "Winter's Tale," from the thickness of the book on left and right the center seems to be appropriately here,

Helprin reveals why Peter Lake is to return after 100 years; why the Short Tails are still chasing him; why Athensor is not dead, why Jackson Mead, Mr.

Mootfowl, and Cecil Wooley are back building bridges. If you can accept such a premise, this book is for you.

The beautiful story takes us out of the 19th century when we see Peter Lake, a second story man, break into the Upper West Side mansion of Isaac captured by the

love of Beverly Penn, who propels him into the timelessness of the universe; through the 20th and into the 21st century when

New York City begins to become the ethereal metropolis of great splendor and promise that everyone has always thought it could be.

Of course, there is more to "Winter's Tale" than time travel. In the interim, we can feel the power of wealth, the ultimate control of nature and the omnipotence of the universe.

The story races across the years 1900 to 1935, dramatically interweaving historical reality with the tragic history of the fictional Tradd family. A quick-paced, entertaining melodramatic saga.

MacLean, Alistair. "Floodgate." Doubleday, 1984.

A brilliant police detective matches wits with a gang of cool professional political terrorists in this rousing new novel by the all-time master of action and intrigue—and the outcome of their contest could decide whether the Netherlands will sink beneath the sea!

Ripley, Alexander. "On Leaving Charleston." Doubleday, 1984.

In a continuation of her previous novel, "Charleston," Ripley here describes the exploits of Garden Tradd, the niece of Charleston's heroine.
