Home health services expand to include hospice care

The Home Health Service, Albemarle Home Care, through the PPCC District Health Department has expanded services to include hospice care. Albemarle Home Care renders services to home bound residents of Pasquotank, Perquimans, Camden, Chowan, and Currituck Counties of all ages and economic groups. The Albemarle Home Care multidisciplinary team includes registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, home health aids, a physical therapist, and a medical social worker. The hospice component of Albemarle Home Care exists neither to hasten nor to postpone death. Rather, hospice exists to affirm life—by providing support and care of those in the last phases of incurable disease so that they can live as fully and comfortable as possible.

Hospice promotes the formation of caring communities that are sensitive to the needs of patients and their families at this time in their lives so that they may be free to attain that degree of mental and spiritual preparation for death that is satisfactory to them. Volunteers, trained through an intensive program, provide companionship as well as help with such specific functions as light housework, child care, and sitting with patients when family members require time away.
