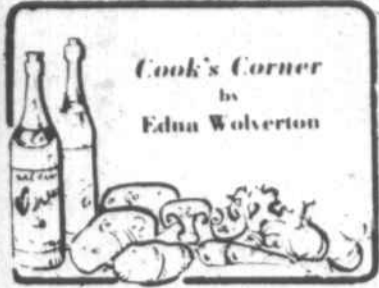

Late tomatoes make an excellent sauce

Perhaps you have an over abundance of late tomatoes in your garden, or maybe a generous neighbor has provided

you with the same. If so, try this homemade tomato sauce. The portions can certainly be changed to accommodate the quantity of available tomatoes.

They prepared the Eggplant Parmesan for your family using your home made sauce. The sauce may be canned or frozen for future use on pasta, veal, or vegetables.



TOMATO SAUCE
1 gallon whole peeled tomatoes
1/4 c. tomato paste
3 T. olive oil

3 cloves garlic, minced
1/4 c. chopped onions
1/4 c. parsley
1 T. oregano
1 T. basil
3 T. grated Romano Cheese
1 T. baking soda (The baking soda cuts the acid. You may substitute sugar, salt and ground pepper to taste.)

Saute the onions and garlic in olive oil in a large pot until the onions are brown. Add remaining ingredients and cook 15 minutes. Stirring constantly to break up the whole tomatoes. The sauce

does not have to be cooked a long time, but if you like you may simmer it for 1 1/2 hours. Feel free to use your other favorite seasonings.

EGGPLANT PARMESAN
1 medium eggplant
1 egg
1 1/2 c. Italian bread crumbs
1 c. grated Parmesan cheese oil for frying
2 c. tomato sauce
6 oz. mazzarella cheese
Peel eggplant and cut into 1/3" slices. Dip slices in crumbs mixed with 1/4 cup Parmesan cheese, and then dip in egg beaten with water. Fry in hot oil, turning once. Place half of the slices in a two quart casserole and top with one cup of sauce. Sprinkle with generous layer of Parmesan cheese. Repeat layers. Top with mozzarella and bake at 350 degrees until hot throughout and cheese is melted and slightly brown, about 30 minutes. Serves four to six.

Nixon earns Boy Scouts highest merit award

Eric Christopher Nixon, 13, of 2615 Derbyshire Road, Maitland, Florida, has earned the highest achievement award the Boy Scouts of America offers to Scouts, the EAGLE AWARD.

Nixon was recognized in ceremonies on August 28 at the Westminster United Presbyterian Church, his troop's sponsor.

A member of Troop 251, Nixon is one of approximately two percent of all Boy Scouts who attains the Eagle rank, according to Scoutmaster David Stout.

Each candidate must earn 21 merit badges and successfully complete a community church or synagogue-related service project to earn his Eagle. Nixon chose to help our national bird, The American Bald Eagle through 'Save Our American Raptors' (S. O. A. R.) Inc., and Florida's Eagle Lady, Mrs. Doris Maeger. LANDSCAPING THE EAGLE EXHIBIT AREA was his project that took over 230 hours of work and the cooperation of more than 17 people working closely together to clear out underbrush, providing parking spaces outlined with mulch and railroad ties, put up fences and build a water pool and seating area in the exhibit area. Nixon also raised \$689 in cash donations for S. O. A. R. to help educate school children and adults about

the eagle and other birds of prey. Eric has served in leadership position as Dean Chief, Librarian, Assistant Patrol Leader, and Senior Patrol Leader. He was recently received into THE ORDER OF THE ARROW.

Nixon is a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Maitland and he is a freshman at Lake Howell High School where his sister, Karen is a Junior. He is the son of Roger and Ann Nixon, and the grandson of Mrs. Malcolm Nixon, of Belvidere.

TAX BRIEFS

The tax laws, the administration of those laws, and the filing of tax returns get more complicated each year. If you are "just aware" as opposed to being "fully educated" on a given tax item, that may be sufficient. Your tax advisor can fill in all the little "niceties." With that in mind, here are just a few "aware's."

- Households where both spouses work may find themselves shelling out additional taxes at filing time unless they make adjustments to their withholdings. Consider reducing your claimed exemptions to 0, and if that doesn't produce enough withholding, give your employer a letter of approval to withhold additional amounts.
- The IRS has discovered that a great many individuals are having accountants prepare their tax returns and, therefore, are using only the mailing labels from the forms and instructions mailed to them each year. Henceforth, certain individuals will be receiving only a mailing label from the IRS.
- If you are a "responsible person" in a corporation, you can be liable for 100% of the FICA and federal income taxes which are withheld from employees but not deposited with the government.
- Some tax exempt bond holders may be denied interest expense deductions. If the IRS feels that you have borrowed money to purchase another investment rather than cashing in tax-free bonds, you may be denied an interest expense deduction.
- Some alimony payments may not be deductible. Some states have laws that specify alimony is no longer payable if the recipient gets remarried. If you reside in such a state and continue to pay unnecessary alimony, your deduction will be lost. The recipient, however, will still be taxed on the funds as income.
