Homemade brownies chase away blahs

Here are two new variations on the old theme—BROWNIES! Who can resist? These fudge brownies are almost candy like while the other version offers you a brownie with a marshmallow layer along with a layer of icing. Serve with a steaming cup of coffee or tea to keep away the January blahs!

FANTASTIC FUDGE BROWNIES
 4 cups sugar
 1 cup flour
 1 cup cocoa
 8 eggs
 1 lb. butter, melted
 4 tablespoons vanilla
 2 cups chopped walnuts

Preheat oven to 300 degrees. Sift flour, sugar and cocoa. Beat eggs well and add dry ingredients, butter, vanilla and nuts. Mix. Pour butter into a 3 quart pan. Place the baking pan in a larger pan containing water. Bake 45-50 minutes. Cool in pan. Brownies will get firmer as they cool. Yield 36 1/2 inch squares

HEAVENLY BROWNIES
 1 1/2 sticks butter
 2 eggs

and mix well. Bake in greased 12x9x2 inch pan in a 350 degrees for 20-25 minutes. When done, sprinkle with marshmallows and return to oven until marshmallows melt. Remove from oven and ice.

ICING
 1 box 10X sugar, sifted
 3 tablespoons cocoa, sifted
 1 teaspoon vanilla
 1 stick melted butter
 milk
 Mix and add enough milk for spreading consistency. Spread over brownies. Cool. Cut.
