2 cups chopped walnuts

Preheat oven to 300 degrees. Sift flour, sugar and cocoa. Beat eggs well and add dry ingredients, butter, vanilla and nuts. Mix. Pour butter into a 3 quart pan. Place the baking pan in a larger pan containing water. Bake 45-50 minutes. Cool in pan. Brownies will get firmer as they cool. Yeild 36 1/2 inch squares
