There will be two stages for the first time with entertainment beginning at 10 a.m. on the Park Stage and running until 5:30 p.m. The program will include regional talent and some of the musicians will be roving along Broad Street from 11 a.m. until 2 p.m.

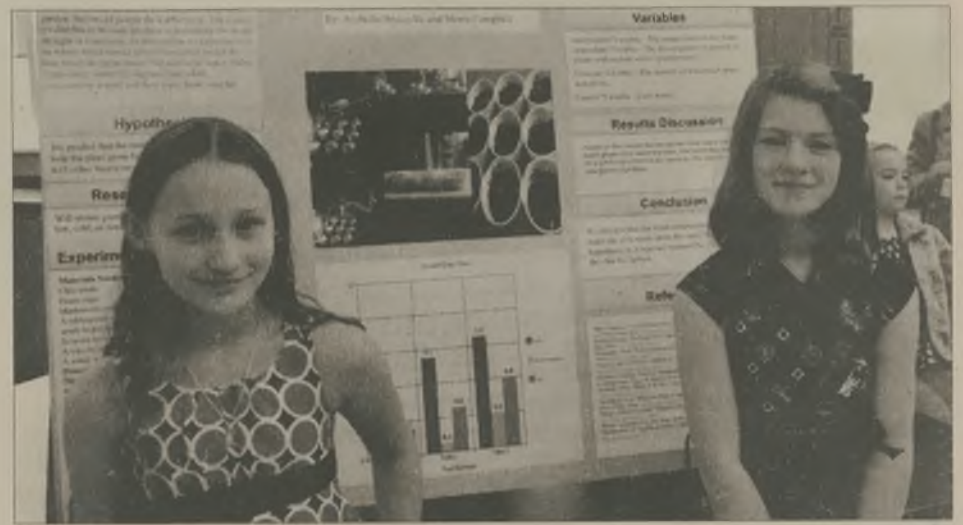
