Dr. C. "A" Lyons, Jr., Chancellor of Fayetteville State University, in accepting the resignation, stated, "I am sure I express the sentiments of all of us when I say that we regret immensely losing a man of Dr. Brown's calibre and one who has been so deeply involved, in a significant way, with the forward thrust of this institution toward the goal of becoming a Full Service University. As a member of the Policy Commission for the Institute of Higher Education Opportunity I look forward to a continuing close working relationship with Dr. Brown."

While at Fayetteville State University, Dr. Brown has contributed support to local community and civic groups through participation on the Board of Directors of the United Fund, The Manpower Advisory Council to the Board of County Commissioners, and he is affiliated with and was elected an Elder at the Haymount Presbyterian Church.

Dr. Brown holds the doctorate degree from New York University. He is the author of numerous articles; the most recent is an "Overview of the Origin and Administrative Organization of Ghanaian Higher Education," which will appear in the May issue of Educational Resources published by George Washington University, Washington, D.C. 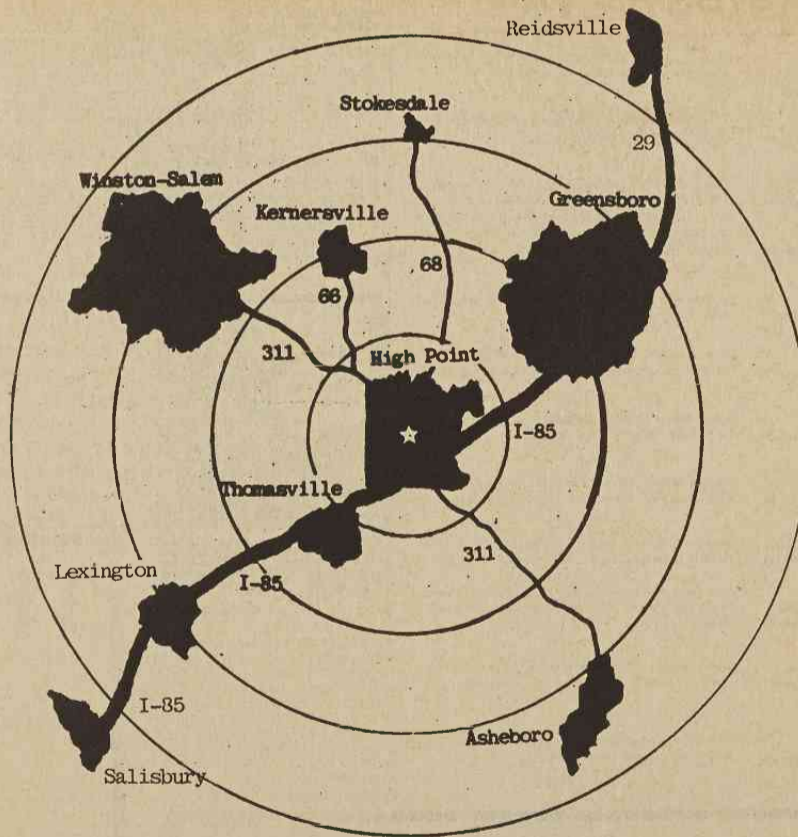
