

GGO Fall-Amateur Championship To Be

GREENSBORO—The second annual GGO Fall-Amateur Championship will be held September 25th and 26th at Bel Aire Golf Club near Greensboro. The Fall-Am will once again be a double-barrel event. Players with handicaps of two or less will be competing for an exemption to play in the 1977 GGO, as well as merchandise prizes. Other amateurs will be vying for merchandise certificates and trophies. Rules were changed last year preventing amateurs from qualifying for TPD events and the only way an amateur can play in the GGO is to gain a sponsor's exemption. Jaycee Larry Dunlap, Fall-Am Chair-

man, said, "We feel that this golf tournament is an excellent means of selecting a top amateur for the GGO field. The Fall-Am also gives the weekend golfer a chance to participate in a GGO-related event and have some fun." The tournament is open to the first 200 entries. The champion-

ship flight will be composed of golfers with handicaps of two or less. Other flights will be established after first-day qualifying scores. Bel Aire Golf Club is a par 72 layout that measures over 6700 yards and is located on highway 68 north of the regional airport. Amateurs outside the

Shaw Bears Ready For Opener

RALEIGH—Despite a series of last minute problems, Shaw University Head Football Coach Horace Small is preparing his team for another gridiron season. The Bears will open the season Saturday, September 11, against Tennessee's Knoxville State College in Enloe Stadium in Raleigh at 2:00 p.m.

The Bears finished the 1975 season with one win eight defeats, and one tie (1-8-1) overall, and no wins, six defeats, and one tie (0-6-1) in the CIAA. According to Coach Small, "a weak offense was the major reason for the poor showing." "This year, we're concentrating our efforts on building a strong and aggressive offense that will be able to score," he said.

Small, beginning his second year at the helm for the Shaw Bears, conducted an extensive recruiting to beef up his offense and mend the defense, crippled by graduation. Gay Walker a sophomore quarterback from Fort Lauderdale, Florida, will lead the Bears attack with Bobby Landers, an out-

standing junior running back expected to carry much of the load. James Phillips, wide receiver, who caught 23 passes for 187 yards last season, will return as the Bears' deep threat.


The defense is extremely young and inexperienced, but is expected to improve as the season progresses. The defensive backfield was severely crippled by the loss of James Smith, all-CIAA safety, and Ron Burrell, but Coach Small expects Curtis Williams a senior cornerback, to take up the slack.

The Bears will be the

guests of Hampton Institute on September 18, and Fayetteville State University on Sept. 25. The Bears return home Saturday, October 9, at 2:00 p.m. in Enloe Stadium, against Federal City College in Washington, D.C.



