
## KINGS MOUNTAIN'S FIRST ORGANIZED FIRE DEPARTMENT



This old log church, the criginal tillars of which are still standing on and now gwied by Mr. Wray Williams, became the mother of twin daughters, giving up her life in heir birth. The daughters are call d Bethany and Pisgah. Pisgah. known to us today as 'Old Pisgah' stood a few miles east of Kings Mountain on tthe present farm of Dr. J. E. Anthony. Ten acres of land were deeded to this organization on Feb. 2, 1801, for the sum of \$28.50.

In 1856 Old Pisgah branched into the present Pisgah and Mount Nebc. Nebo was made of the western sec tion of the old congregation and stood about a mile and a half west o' Kings Mountain just across from P. D. Herndon's farm. In the early '706, Mr. Robert Falls who owned practically all of the land upon. which the present town is located. gave land for a new church in the l'tile village. This church was first used in 1876. standing on King Street including the present homes of P. D. Herndon, Mrs. Minnie-Craw ford and Ace Goforth. The sainted rustor of Pisgah and Mt. Nebo-Dr. E. E. Boyce - continued as the pas tor of the village church.




