### FARM QUESTIONS

Q.—What is the best green feed for poultry in winter?

A.—Cured alfalfa hay, lespedeza, or clover hay make good greens for winter use provided the green color is retained. Alfalfa leaf meal, if green in color, also makes a satisfactory feed, but should not constitute more than ten percent of the mash. This feed is much preferred to alfalfa meal which has a high fiber content, but neither is as satisfactory as green alfalfa hay. All the hays should be fed in racks as the birds will eat only the leaves and the stems can then be thrown in the litter.

Q.—Should shade trees be pruned in winter the same as fruit trees or shrubs?

A.—No. Many beautiful groves are ruined each year by quick tree surgeons or by superstitious per-

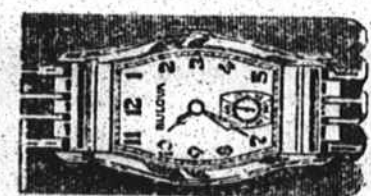
