The fires that never go out!
THE ORIGINAL FIRES STARTED IN THE OLD "HESTER STREET" PLANT (Feb. 14 1825) OF NEW YORK CITY'S FIRST GAS COMPANY HAVE NEVER TO THIS DAY GONE OUT!

Funeral services for Mrs. John T. Carpenter, 89, were held at St. Mark's Lutheran Church near Cherryville, Tuesday afternoon. Her death occurred at her home in Cherryville on Monday afternoon and came as a surprise to her many friends and relatives. She had been suffering from the infirmities of old age for some time but had only been ill for a day or two before her death.
 Mrs. Carpenter lived for many years in Kings Mountain. She was before marriage Miss Sarah Elizabeth Crouse, a sister of the late C. S. Crouse of Kings Mountain. Her family were prominent in the religious and social life of the St. Marks community near Cherryville.
 Her late husband, Sergeant John T. Carpenter, died four years ago at the age of 98 and was the oldest Confederate veteran in this part of the State.
 Mrs. Carpenter is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Joe Garrett of Kings Mountain and Mrs. T. E. Plonk of Cherryville, one son, W. Rufus Carpenter of Cherryville. She

is also survived by five grandchildren, 11 great-grandchildren and 4 great-great-grandchildren.
 A number of relatives and friends from Kings Mountain attended the last rites.
