Crimson Clover Seed To be bought in State

North Carolina tarmers who plant crimson clover this fall and harvest it for seed next spring with be able to sell the seed to the Feaoral government, says E. Y. Floyd AAA executive officer of N. C. State College. The Commodity Cred it Corporation will buy trimson clover seed and turn it over to the Triple-A for distribution as a grantof-aid.

The seed will be purchased Floyd said, "only from farmers cooperating in the Agricultural Conservation Program who comply with acroage allotinent provisions of the AAA. The crimson clover purchase program is almen in enlarging the 1941 domestic production of seed and increasing the acreage of winter cover crops in Southern and East Central States."

The Commodity Credit Corporation will pay a basic rate of 10 cents per pound for recleaned seed which meets the following require ments: 96 percent purity, free of noxious weeds, and showing at lease 85 percent germination. The price of 10 cents per pound is slight ly above that afforded by the market in 1940.

"The Federal seed purchase program is not intenled to keep any private dealer from buying crimson clover seed." Floyd emphasized. Farmers cooperating with the AAA program are free to sell their seed either to the Commodity Credit Corporation at the rate of 10 cents per pound or o regular seed dealers at the price they are able to pay.

This is the first such program for crimson clover, which is used extensively as a winter cover crop by farmers of Tennessee. North Caroli na, and other states in the East Central Region. It is from these Sta tes that the Federal government will buy seed for grant-of-aid distribution.
