Southern To Add Streamlined Deluxe Trains

Washington, D. C., Nov. 12.—"The Southerner" and "The Tennessean" are the names selected for Southern Railway System's new streamlined deluxe coach trains which are scheduled to be placed in service between New York and New Orleans and Washington and Memphis early in 1941. Southern Railway officials announced today.

Announcement of the purchase of six Diesel - electric locomotives and 42 coaches, described as of "the latest design and construction," was made by the Southern Railway in October and the Electro-Motive Corporation and the Pullman-Standard Car Manufacturing Co. have now begun work on these streamlines. The Southern will furnish a new daily service, each way, between New York and New Orleans thru Washington, Atlanta, Birmingham, Meridian and Hattiesburg and will provide substantially faster train service over existing schedules.

COTTON GINNING REPORT

The cotton census report shows that 35,440 bales of cotton were ginned in Cleveland County, N. C., from the crop of 1940 prior to Nov. 1, 1940, as compared with 52,737 bales for the crop of 1939.
