**Western Union Taking Messages To Italy Now**  
 For the first time in five years personal and business international messages may be sent to Italy if they are unopposed by Miss Annie Houston, manager of the Western Union Telegraph office here.  
 Government and press messages have been permitted for some time but only with the improvement of conditions in Italy has it been possible to re-establish communication for the public.  
 The new rates for international communications established on May 1 make it possible for Kings Mountain people now to communicate not only with Italy but with other European countries, South America, Central America and the West Indies for 25 cents a word for a full rate message, 13 cents a word for a deferred message and 12 1/2 cents a word for an overnight message.
