

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals will be received by the Board of Trustees of Cleveland County Hospitals, Shelby, North Carolina, at the Shelby Hospital, Shelby North Carolina, until 2:00 o'clock P. M., E. S. T., Friday, November 18th, and immediately thereafter publicly opened and read, for the furnishing of labor and materials and equipment entering into the construction of a General Hospital at Kings Mountain, N. C., including boiler plant, roads, walks, drives, equipment, and appurtenances thereto. Proposals received after the hour and date specified above will not be considered.

Separate bids will be received for the General Contract, the Electrical Contract, the Plumbing Contract, and the Heating and Ventilating Contract.

Complete plans, specifications and contract documents will be open for inspection at the Hospital, Shelby, N. C., and in the office of Walter Hook and Associates, Incorporated, 303 1/2 West Fourth Street, Charlotte, N. C. Plans, specifications, and other contract documents may be obtained by prime contractors upon deposit of \$30.00 in cash or check, for General Contract; \$20.00 in cash or check for Plumbing, Heating and Ventilating, Electrical Contracts. The full deposit will be returned to contractors submitting bona fide proposals, provided plans and specifications are returned to the Architect in good condition within five days after the date set for receiving of bids. Subcontractor's deposits will be refunded less cost of printing and handling.

All Contractors are hereby notified that they must have proper license under the State laws governing their respective trades.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a cash deposit, or by a Certified Check drawn on and certified by some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in an amount equal to not less than 5% of the bid plus a bid bond of 3% of the bid; said deposit to be retained by the Owner as liquidated damages in event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract within ten days after the award, or to give satisfactory surety as required by law. (Public laws 1933, Section 1, Chapter 400, General Statutes of North Carolina, 1943, - 143 Art. 8 S. 129.)

Performance Bond will be required in amount of one hundred per cent (100%) of the contract price.

Payment Bond will be required in amount of fifty per cent (50%) of the contract price.

Payment will be made on the basis of ninety per cent (90%) of monthly estimates and final payment made upon completion and acceptance of the work.

No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of thirty days.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive formalities.
