A PROCLAMATION

Whereas the Fathers of our country defined the purpose of its founding to be "to form a more perfect union," and

Whereas its first President declared that to achieve this end we must "give to bigotry no sanction, to persecution no assistance, and

Whereas our way of life, granted to us as a heritage, which we must safeguard for future generations, is threatened by the forces of Communism which would destroy our liberties, now

STILL, Mayor of Kings Mountain, do call upon our citizens to join with other Americans in the observance of the week of Washington's Birthday, February 17-24, as Brotherhood Week, as a period to affirm anew, and to rededicate ourselves to the practice of the Brotherhood of Man under the Fatherhood of God.
