

## Davidson Bears Suffer 1st Loss

Davidson high school's boys basketball team tasted defeat for the first time this season on last Thursday night at Charlotte, blowing a five-point lead in the final quarter to go down to Huntersville high 52 to 48 in a thriller. Huntersville's girls also won, 46-25.

The previous night, on January 30, Davidson's Bears had run their victory string out to six in a row by dumping Cleveland high of Shelby 44-36. Cleveland's girls won in a low scoring contest 14-12.

The Huntersville doubleheader was not a conference affair. The two teams were to tangle at Cherryville last night (Wednesday). On Friday and Saturday, the boys are entered in a round robin tournament at John Chavis gymnasium.

## Two Bound To Superior Court

A total of six cases were heard and tried in City Recorder's court Monday afternoon at City Hall. Judge E. A. Harrill presided.

Probable cause was found against Julius E. Coleman and Jimmy G. Coleman, age 17, each charged with false pretense. Both were bound over to Superior court under \$500 bonds.

Police arrested the two men, who are father and son, and a younger Coleman on Jan. 15, but were released under bonds. They were charged with soliciting money on the pretense that they were going to use it to replace their home which had burned.

The younger Coleman was sent to Shelby for trial in juvenile court.
