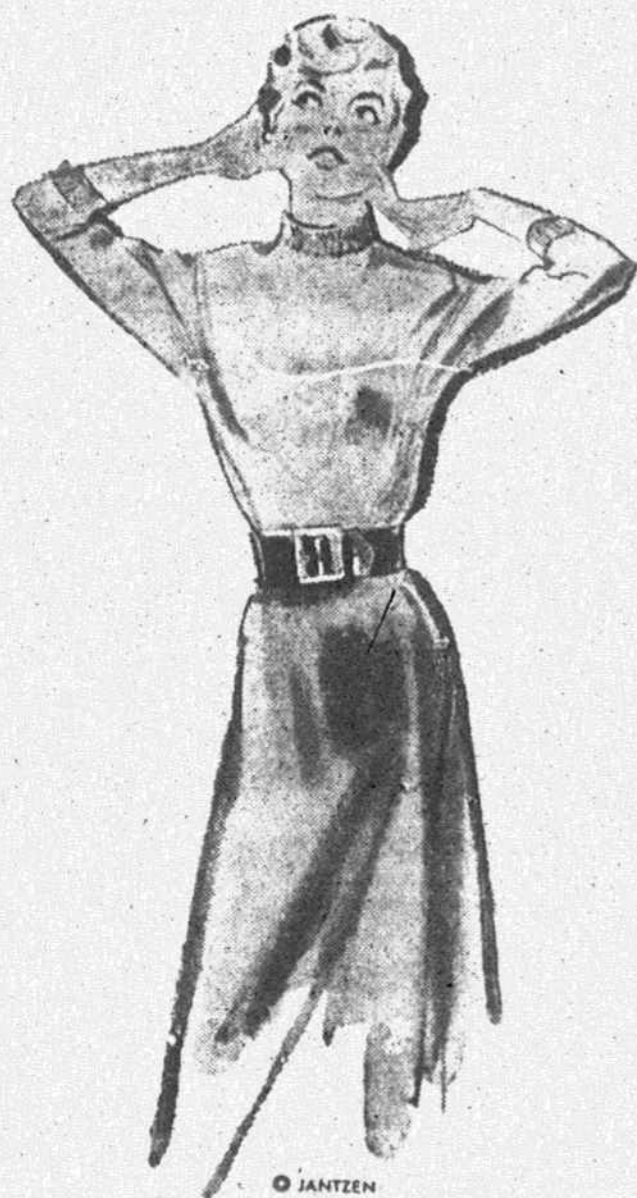
Small Eggs To Appear On Market
