Communism ---

Alger Hiss sold America down the drain to Russia. He was a chief adviser at the Yalta, Potsdam and Teheran conferences that enabled Stalin to enslave 600 million people and one-third of the world without firing a shot. Truman called the Hiss trial a "Red Herring" in spite of the fact that three different important men had tried for 10 years to tell him that Hiss was a communist.
