Green Pastures Awards Listed

Ten North Carolina Counties winners in the 1952 State Green Pastures Program sponsored by the Governor's Green Pastures Committee - will be honored at ceremonies in November. S. H. Bobson, pasture specialist for the State College Extension Service, has announced.

The winning counties are Cabarrus, Chatham, Currituck, Forsyth, Graham, Henderson, Person, Stanly, Union, and Wake. Each will receive a large green-and-white flag bearing the words "Green Pastures Citation, 1952." The flags are donated by the National Fertilizer Association.

Tentative plans are being made to award the flags at ceremonies to be held in the various county seats sometime in November. The awards are presented annually to the 10 counties having the highest percentage of their farmers to receive certificates and plaques in the Green Pastures Program. Certificates are awarded to farmers who have seeded at least one acre of improved pasture per animal unit. Plaques are
