Mrs. Fred A. McDaniel, Sr., underwent an operation Wednesday morning in the N. C. University hospital at Chapel Hill.

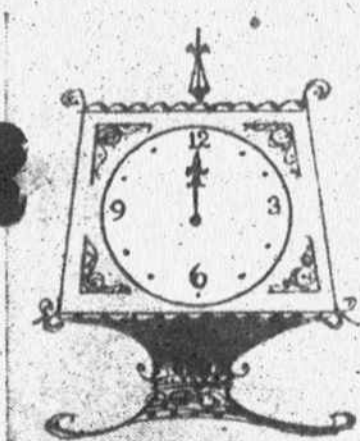
Mrs. Ann Roberts returned last Wednesday from Memorial Hospital in Charlotte where she had undergone treatment for several days.
