**Farm Water Systems Need Good Planning**

A carefully planned and efficient water system can save work and speed up farm operations in addition to adding to the comfort, safety, and convenience of farm living, says county agent Howard Clapp.

Mr. Clapp points out that it is well to plan for increased consumption in estimating the amount of water that a new or enlarged power system will be called upon to furnish, since experience shows that farm families use more water when it is easily available. It has also been demonstrated that animals gain weight more rapidly and milk cows produce more milk when they are provided with plenty of water at all times.

Agricultural engineers estimate that water will be used at the following rate for each individual served: 50 gallons a day for each member of the family; 35 gallons a day for each milk cow; 12 gallons for each horse, dry cow, or beef cow; four gallons for each hog; two gallons for each sheep; and four gallons for each 100 chickens.

All potential needs or uses should be considered in planning not only the capacity of the water system but the location of pipelines, he says. Hours of labor each day can be eliminated by piping rather than hauling water to livestock quarters. And a strategic fund are to be in. A. H. Patterson is serving as treasurer of the building fund.

**ANSWERS TO YOUR FARM QUESTIONS**

**QUESTION:** What materials can I use to kill woody growths on my farm?

**ANSWER:** The use of mixture of 2,4-D and 2,4,5-T has been useful in spray solutions for the control of woody type plants. Results have been generally good where a combination of these two materials located hose can prove invaluable for putting out fires in farm buildings.

**QUESTION:** Is there any way to keep wild garlic from growing up in my wheat and oats?

**ANSWER:** Yes, It has been done with heavy applications of nitrogen and heavy applications of 2,4-D in tests. The experiments indicate that if you manage small grain so it will give the greatest possible competition to wild garlic, then follow up with one to one and a half pounds of 2,4-D per acre, the weed can be controlled.

**QUESTION:** How can I get rid of ragged robin and chickweeds in my alfalfa?

**ANSWER:** Spray when alfalfa is dormant during the fall, winter, or early spring and while weeds are small and growing rapidly, using water soluble Dinitro at the rate of one and a half to three pounds acid equivalent. Be sure to use enough spray to wet the plants.
