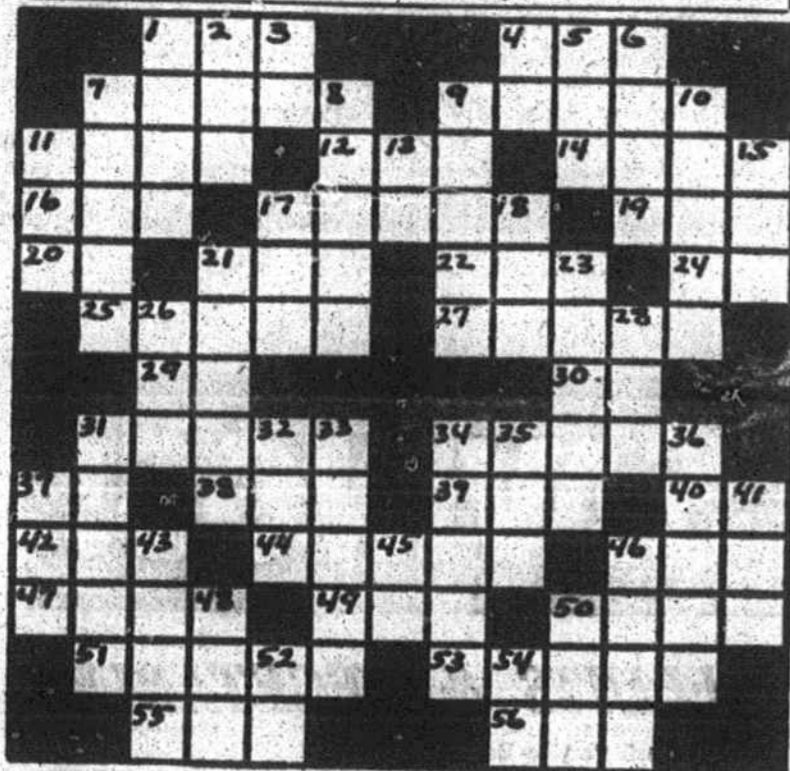

Annual Charlotte Soap Box Derby Warm Up Scheduled Here June 16

The warm up race for the annual Soap Box Derby in Charlotte has been scheduled in Kings Mountain for June 16, at 4 o'clock.

Plans are now for the race to be run from the top of the hill on South Railroad avenue between W. King and W. Mountain streets.

The Kings Mountain race is being conducted by the Junior Chamber of Commerce with local firms sponsoring the contestants. The Jaycees are assisting Charlotte officials with the Charlotte Derby and Victory Chevrolet Co. is one of the Charlotte area sponsors.

The winner of the warm up race will be given a special prize. Charles Dixon, chairman of the Jaycee committee said.

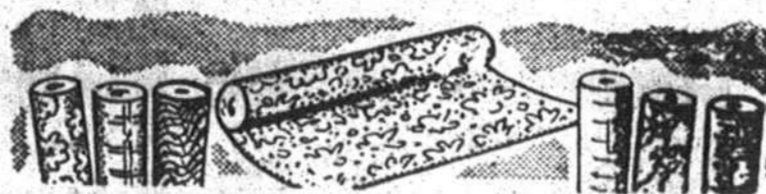

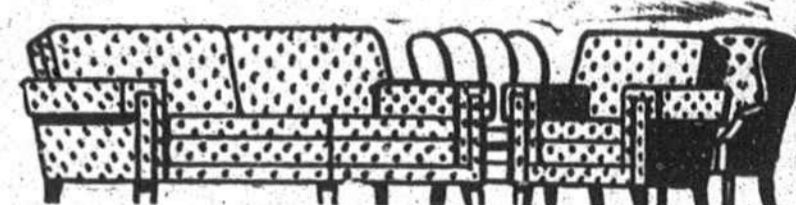
