

DESIGN C-309. For a limited budget and a narror lot, this plan has much to offer. There are three bedrooms, bath, living room and a kitchen-dinette, which can be opened into the living room by means of a folding partition. There is a full basement down from the grade

The central hall assures privacy for all rooms and excellent circulation through the house. Cabinets occupy opposite walls of the kitchen with refrigerat . and stove in the cabinets on the inside wall.

Exterior finish consists of shingle and vertical siding, planting area, and pitch and gravel roofing on a flat roof constructed to carry necessary snow loads. Floor eara is 936 sq. ft. and cubage is, 15,912 ou. ft.


