


UNEXCAVATED DESIGN C-310-5

DESIGN C-310-S. This three level plan can face the street either way, depending on the width of the lot. There are three good-sized bedrooms. two on the upper level, with the bath, and one on the lower level which also has a lavatory, laundry and furnace room.

The main floor level contains a large living room and a combination kitchen · dinette which can open into the living room. This level has wood floor construction over a crawl space.

Exterior finish includes both vertical and wide siding, gable roof over the living room, and a flat roof over the bedroom wing. Closets are plentiful on all three levels. Floor area is 980 sq. ft., with cubage 18,900 cu. ft.






