which can be legally claimed as a charitable deduction. You are entitled only to the exact amount of your contributions, and you are expected to have in your possession all the records needed suppers by reservation. needed to prove the validity of your claim.

As a general rule, the totol of your contributions are not expected to exceed more than 20 percent of your total income. However, you may add an additional 10 percent if the money went o religious, charitable, scigift is deductible. School or college tuition is not considered a

ons, you are entitled to claim all contributions made to nonprofit schools and hospitals, the Salvation Army, Red Cross, Community Chest, Camp Fire Girls, Boy and Girl Scouts, voluntary health organizations, non-profit organizations and societies for the prevention of cruelty to chil-

dren and animals.

The key word when estimating non-cash contributions is "fair market value". If you attended a theatre party which donated all proceeds to a recognized charity, you are entitled to deduct the normal cost of the play or enter-tainment from the total amount of the ticket and list the difference as a contribution.

If you bid \$10 for a box lunch at a church sponsored affair, and the lunch has a fair market value of \$1.50, you may deduct the remaining \$8.50. The fair market value of household goods or articles donated to a charitable agency may also be claimed but don't forget to ask for a re-

Volunteer hospital workers may deduct transportation expenses to and from work, including gas and oil, the cost of any required uniform plus laundering expenses a dnthe cost of meals and lodging incurred when volunteering services. Den Mothers for the Brownies, Cub Scouts, Girl and Boy Scouts may deduct travel expenses for field trips as well as the cost of refreshments served at group meetings. Church delegates can deduct transportation, meals and lodging while attending church business unless they have previously een compensated for their servces or reimbursed for their ex-

Paintings, bonds, securities, obiects of art which are donated to a religious or charitable institution are also deducted at the fair market value. A painting pur-chased for \$100 two years be-fore may be worth either more or less than the original investment. In either case, you should eport the current market value.
