## Lithium Gives Sales Report

Lithium Corporation of America, Inc., today reported consolidated net sales of the company and its subsidiary, Beryllium Metals & Chemicals Corporation, amounted to \$1,501,181 for the three months ended March 31, 1965, as compared with sales of \$1,410,354 for LCA alone during the same period last year.

## Celanese Announces Quarter Earnings

New York — Celanese Corporation of America had 1965 first-quarter net earnings of \$14,510,000, equal to \$1.15 a common share, on sales of \$202,138,000, Harold Blanche, chairman, reported today. Both sales and earnings were the highest for any quarter in the corporation's history.

This year's first-quarter dollar earnings were 18 percent higher than the \$12,549,000 earnings for the first three months of 1964 and sales for the 1965 first-quarter were 25 percent higher than the \$161,712,000 sales for the comparable quarter last year. (The increases are based on comparable 1964 first-quarter figures, reflecting the poolings of interest of two new subsidiaries during the latter part of last year.)

Celanese is a major international chemical company. The corporation and affiliates manufacture a diversified line of 100 basic products, including petrochemicals, fibers, forest products, paints and coatings and petroleum products and they operate 70 plants, with more than 35,000 employees, in the U. S., Canada, Latin America, Western Europe and the Far East.

## Haskell L. Littlejohn Finishes Army School

BAD TOLZ, GERMANY (AHT-NC) — Specialist Four Haskell L. Littlejohn, 24, whose wife, Lola, lives at the Stough Apartments, Phenix City, Ala., was graduated from the Seventh U. S. Army Noncommissioned Officer Academy in Bad Tolz, Germany, May 7.

Specialist Littlejohn received four weeks of training in leadership responsibilities, exercise of command, map reading and military teaching methods.

Regularly assigned as an armor crewman in Troop K of the 3rd Armored Cavalry Regiment's 3rd Reconnaissance Squadron near Kaiserslautern, Germany, Littlejohn entered the Army in February 1961 and arrived overseas in April 1964.

Littlejohn, son of Robert Littlejohn, Route 2, Box 553, Kings Mountain, N. C., was graduated from Davidson High School, Kings Mountain, in 1958.
