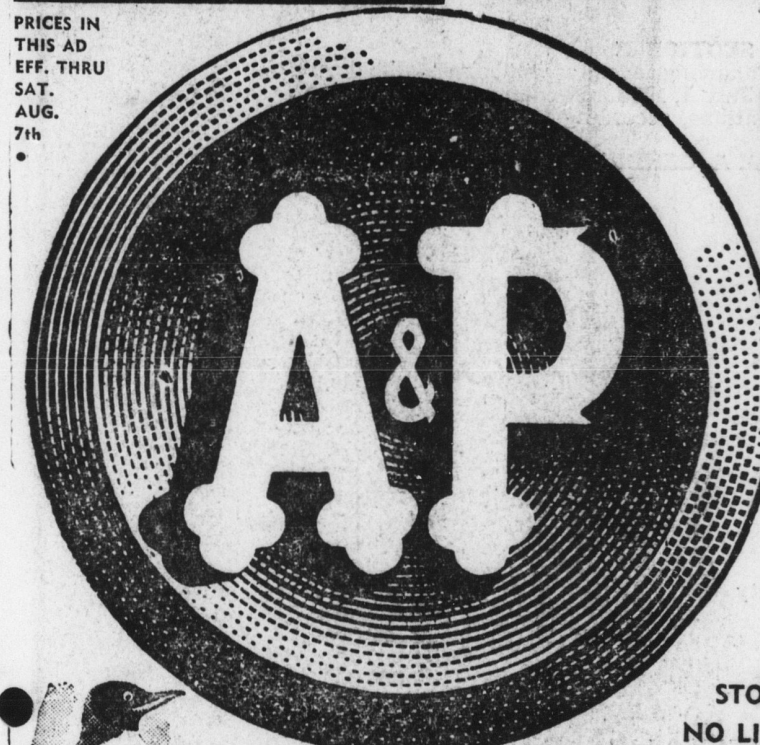

Mrs. Phillips' Rites Conducted In Gaffney, S. C.

Funeral rites for Mrs. Clara Carpenter Phillips, 77, prominent in Gaffney, South Carolina's social and religious life for many years, were held at 4 p.m. from Shuford - Hatcher Chapel, interment following in Oakland cemetery.

Mrs. Phillips was a Kings Mountain native, daughter of the late Anderson P. and Callie Hoke Carpenter. She was the wife of J. Vernon Phillips, Sr., widely known civil engineer.

She died about 6:10 p.m. last Wednesday at her home following illness of several years.

Mrs. Phillips attended Elizabeth college in Charlotte and taught athletics there for two years. Married to Mr. Phillips June 18, 1912, they came to Gaffney from Athens, Ga. in 1920.

As consignee Mrs. Phillips had been in charge of the Texas Oil Company's business here for a number of years. She was serving her 31st consecutive year as president of the Cherokee County Tuberculosis Association. She was a member of the Cherokee County Board of Health and was instrumental in obtaining the new health center on South Logan street.

At one time or another Mrs. Phillips had been head of various civic organizations, including the Daniel Morgan Chapter of the DAR of which she was vice regent at the time of her death. She was a member of the Cherokee County Library Board; the Gaffney Woman's club, the Moses Wood chapter, United Daughters of the Confederacy and the Cherokee County Mental Health Board. She was an active member of Gaffney First Baptist church and had served several times as president of the church's Women's Missionary Society.

As one of the sponsors of the Colonel Williams Chapter of the

Children of the American Revolution, Mrs. Phillips was interested in preserving historical data of the period of the revolution. She was one of the chief promoters of the development of the Cowpens Battleground site for a federal movement.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Phillips is survived by a daughter, Mrs. William R. Brown of Gaffney; two sons, J. V. Phillips, Jr. of Gaffney and William A. Phillips of Kingsport, Tennessee; two sisters, Mrs. Oscar Long of Jacksonville, Fla. and Miss Fannie Carpenter of Kings Mountain; two brothers, Clarence and Troy Carpenter of Kings Mountain and five grandchildren.
