## Report Wages For IRS Service

If YOU ARE A BABY SITTER OUTSIDE your home and the person you work for pays you at least \$50 in cash on one of these 3-month periods: January, February, March; April, May June; July, August, September; October, November, December. THIS PERSON MUST REPORT YOUR IWAGES FOR SOCIAL SECUR. WAGES FOR SOCIAL SECUR-ITY PURPOSES. Therefore, she may withhold your share of the social security tax (3 5/8%) from your wages. She will send in this amount, plus a similar amount of her own...along with your name and your social security account number...to the In-ternal Revenue Service. The wages paid you will be credited to your individual social security wage record.

These reports of your wages will build credit for: payments for yourself and your family in your old-age or if you become disabled: payments for your family in case of your death.

Your employer may not be a-ware of the fact that your wages are covered by the Social Security program. (As little as \$4 a week adds up to more than \$50 in three months, if you are regularly employed.) You owe it to yourself to remind her...and to make sure she has your correct social security account number.

YES, this rule applies to young baby sitters as ones. And you both are building toward future benefits. (If you don't provide the social security number to the employer, you may not get social security cred-
