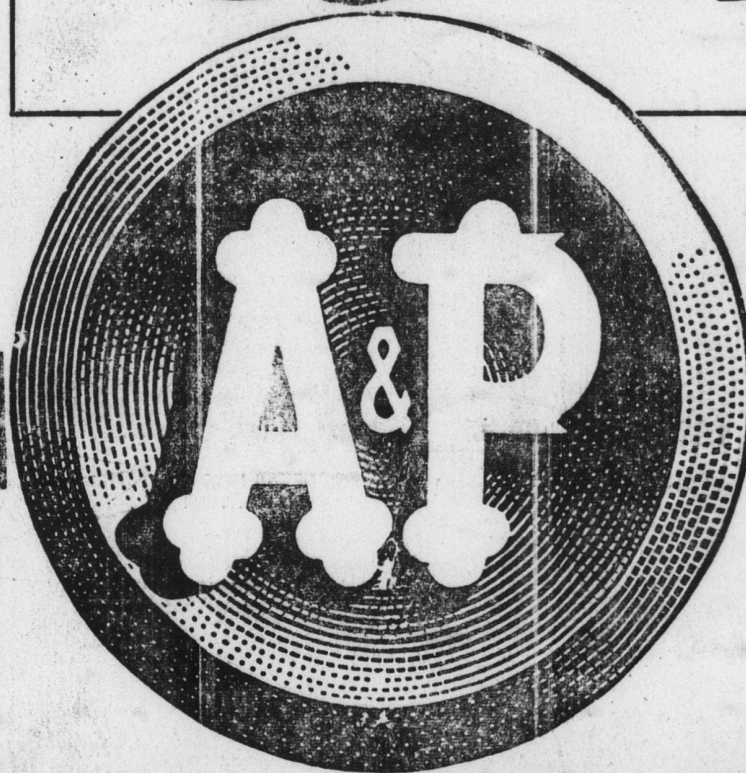

Mr. Winchester stated many veterans may wish to file a service connected claim in order to have a better chance to qualify for the service insurance. There are also other advantages to establishing service connection. Orphans Education Benefits have been denied some children of peacetime veterans, as the requirement had been more restricted. Now children of peacetime veterans qualify on the same basis as those of wartime. Any children who have recently been disallowed this Veterans Administration benefit should contact the service officer to have the application reconsidered.

Housing Market Sees Building Inching Up

WASHINGTON, D. C.—Things are happening in the housing market. Construction is inching up after months of sitting still. New government rules make purchase and financing easier. For the first time rent subsidies are offered to the poor and the elderly. Here are details on these and other developments from the (current issue of) Changing Times, the Kiplinger magazine. Plenty of new houses. Most communities report no scarcity. Prices: trending upward, a result of higher land and material costs. There's a small boom in town houses and row houses (\$15,000 and less). Financing is no problem. Mortgage money has been, and will continue to be ample. Terms are liberal. Lower down payments are now possible in many cases. Mortgage rates a phenomenon. While most other interest rates have gone up, mortgage rates have edged downward or stayed put—same levels as in 1958. How about an apartment? In recent years, up to 40% of all new homes have been apartments. The current trend favors fewer efficiencies and more one- and two-bedroom units. Help for low-income. Over the next four years, 375,000 houses and apartments will be built for rent to the nation's impoverished families and individuals. Low-income people will get 25% of what they earn each month for rent, and the federal government will pay the rest. Most of Mexico's coastline is on the Gulf of California and the Pacific Ocean.
