Keep the air moist, with a humidifier if necessary. Dry air requires a higher temperature to maintain equal comfort.

After you set the thermometer in the morning leave it alone, unless no one is home during the day. For comfort and economy, turn heat control down at night, but not below 65 degrees. You won't save on fuel bills if the furnace has to do double work in the morning to bring the temperature up more than 5 or 6 de-

Close off rooms or parts of the house not being used, Miss Womble advises Draw draperies or shades at sundown. The dead-air pocket behind them acts as insulation.

Doing these things now will protect your family from cold weather this winter and spring. Keeping these facts in mind all year long, will help you get ready for old man winter before he issues his first icy blasts next
