





Raleigh — Applications for the Prospective Teacher Scholarship Loan Fund, a program created by the 1957 General Assembly to encourage students to train as teachers, must be submitted no later than March 1, 1969. Stulents interested in teaching in the North Carolina public schools and who are in need of financial assistance for college training during the 1969-70 school year should write to: Scholarship Section, Division of Teacher Educa-tion, Department of Public In-

According to Morris C. Brown, supervisor of the Teacher Schol arship Loan Program Loan Pro gram, about 600 awards will be made in March and April. Each recipient will receive \$600 per recipient will receive \$600 per year for up to four years of study. "Priority will be given to applicants who plan to teach in elementary grades; however, er areas of study will be considered," he said.
