## Talks On Tape To Servicemen Via Red Cross

"Voices from Home," a program to send tape-recorded messages to overseas servicemen, was announced today by the local unit of the American Red Cross. This gives family and friends of servicemen in foreign countries a chance to talk to them in messages recorded locally.

The Red Cross Cleveland County unit is furnishing the free recording tape and a mailing bag. Each of the county's radio stations is donating technical assistance and facilities. Thus, anyone interested in talking by tape to a serviceman outside the continental United States simply goes to Radio Station WADA, WKMT, or WOHS. Personnel there will assist in preparing the tape which is then mailed by the person to the serviceman.

The radio stations will be open to make "Voices from Home" tapes between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, during the period Monday, November 17 through Wednesday, December 10.

Mrs. Carolyn Freeman, chairman of the Red Cross Service to Military Families committee, expressed appreciation to the "public-spirited radio stations for their cooperation in this project." She and Boyce Morrison, Chairman of the Cleveland County unit, ARC, joined in urging area people to use this opportunity to convey a personal message and to send a "Voice from Home" to all our servicemen at Christmas time.
