The cost per pound of lithium mined is confidential. However, before this mine opened two years ago the company found it cheaper to buy all their ore (concen trate) from Foote Mineral and to abandon their Lincolnton mine which may be reopened at a lat-er date. Their presently mined deposit between Cherryville and Bessemer City is expected to last 15 years at present demand.

The U. S. Government Survey mapped the minerals of the area many years ago but the best maps now in USGS possession are those of T. L. Kesler, former K. M. resident and former Foote Mineral geologist, now a private consulting geologist in Rome, Ga., says Gerald Blanton another geologist.


