

Carolinas Spodumene Belt Once Undeveloped In Kings Mountain

The Carolinas tin spodumene belt was once the largest undeveloped spodumene pegmatite area in the Carolinas. Now developed, it stretches the 30 miles from Grover to Lincolnton running through Kings Mountain.

Dotted along its meandering 1/4 mile to non-existent width are the mines relieving it of its burden.

"Ore is any mineral a company can make a profit on," says John Nelson, geologist with Lithium Corporation of America. From the window of his office can be seen the company's second mine on the Hallman Beam spodumene pegmatite deposit and the kudzu vine covered lush green countryside.

The massive equipment outside mines 1 ton of earth in exchange for 10 pounds of lithium. But the tin in the belt is not economically feasible to mine.

The cost per pound of lithium mined is confidential. However, before this mine opened two years ago the company found it cheaper to buy all their ore (concentrate) from Foote Mineral and to abandon their Lincolnton mine which may be reopened at a later date. Their presently mined deposit between Cherryville and Bessemer City is expected to last 15 years at present demand.

The U. S. Government Survey mapped the minerals of the area many years ago but the best maps now in USGS possession are those of T. L. Kesler, former K. M. resident and former Foote Mineral geologist, now a private consulting geologist in Rome, Ga., says Gerald Blanton another geologist.

Burlington Industries has announced that its Aid to Education Program has extended educational loans totaling \$1.85 million to 2,487 students since the program began in 1946.
